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OPID BYLAWS

BYLAWS OF ONDO PROGRESSIVE INDIGENES IN DIASPORA (OPID)

1. Membership Application

Applicants shall:

- Complete the prescribed application.
- Pay the admission fee.
- Participate in screening.
- Obtain approval by members.

The admission fee shall be ₦500,000 (Five Hundred Thousand Naira) and shall be **non-refundable**.

2. Attendance

Members shall maintain at least 70% attendance annually.

3. Financial Obligations

Annual dues shall be ₦500,000 and shall be paid during the first quarter of each year.

Late payment shall attract a 5% monthly penalty.

Payments may be made in two installments during financial hardship upon prior approval.

4. Welfare Requests

Requests shall be submitted to the Welfare Officer.

The Executive Committee shall determine eligibility.

5. Election Procedures

An Electoral Committee may be established.

Voting may be secret ballot or electronic.

6. Committee Operations

Committees shall report to the Executive Committee.

7. Code of Conduct

Members shall:

- Conduct themselves honorably.
- Respect fellow members.
- Protect the reputation of OPID.

8. Virtual Meetings

Electronic meetings shall carry equal validity with physical meetings.

9. Handover

Outgoing officers shall complete handover within thirty days.

10. Interpretation

The Executive Committee shall interpret these bylaws subjects to the authority of the General Assembly.

11. Adoption

This Bylaws shall take effect upon adoption by the founding members of OPID.
